Endodontic Management of Dens Invaginatus

An 11 year-old female was referred by a general dentist for evaluation and management of an infection associated with tooth #7. Clinical and radiographic examination (including a 3D CBCT scan) revealed the following:

- No significant medical findings
- Pulpal diagnosis: Necrosis
- Periapical diagnosis: Symptomatic Apical Periodontitis
- Large periapical radiolucency (11mm x 10mm) with little/ no hard tissue surrounding root
- Class II mobility
- No significant probing depths (2-3mm circumferentially)
- Type II Dens Invaginatus (Invagination extends beyond the CEJ into the pulp chamber)
- Case difficulty: High (considering patient behavior, size/extent of the invagination, thinness of dentinal walls, "peg" shape of clinical crown, incomplete root formation with blunderbuss apex)

The risks and benefits of treatment options were presented to the patient and her mother. The patient/mother elected root canal treatment. Treatment was completed using MTA as the obturation material and a final restoration was placed. At 3-months, the patient was asymptomatic and the tooth had no significant probing depths, class I mobility, and significant radiographic improvement with hard tissue healing. The patient is still on regular recalls to monitor healing.

The decision of whether to preserve a tooth requiring endodontic treatment or to replace it can often involve a challenging and multifactorial treatment planning process. Various factors need to be considered, such as clinician's expertise, strategic location of the

tooth, bone quality, soft-tissue quality and quantity, the patient's periodontal status, tooth restorability, and the patient's age and medical history. As a dental community, we are trained to preserve the natural dentition for our patients. We appreciate the continual opportunity to work with you and your team to provide the best treatment to your patients.
